8.15pm

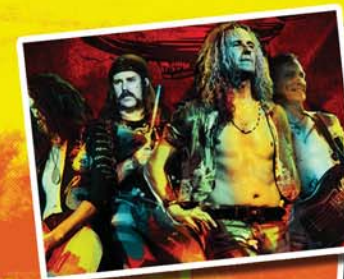
CORDUROY
